Content and Motivation:

From Norway to Turkey, we are connected by the European Green Belt. It is a place of eventful history and is a reminder of the division but also of the peaceful revolutions of 1989. The transformation of the Iron Curtain into today's Green Belt. Boundaries separate. Nature connects!

Together, we want to make it more visible. We want to set a positive example for sustainability – peace – democracy. With encounters, music and conversations. In Europe. In a time of crisis, uncertainty and wars.

The prelude to this action was an event on the occasion of the 35th anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall at Grenzhus Schlagsdorf, on the former inner-German border in Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, during the Green Belt Days in September 2024.

This year we will sing together at the Grenzhus on June 28, 2025, and hope that there will also be singing at other places along the Green Belt.

During the next years, the focus will be on national and international network building, coordination and public relations, as well as cooperation with the European coordinators of the Green Belt. Gradually, the Green Belt will develop into a Singing Green Belt: choirs of children and adults from churches or villages, singer-songwriters, classical musicians, rock bands, – from 24 countries all together on the former Iron Curtain.
